Interest free "Hardship Fund" loans are available for up to \$2,500.00\* to any Active status (nonretired) IATSE Local 728 member, up to 200 members per year who meet qualification requirements. \**Union officers are limited to a maximum loan of \$2,000.00* 

Loan requests will be accepted beginning on 9/27/24. If you are an eligible member, you can request assistance of up to  $$2,500.00^*$

# **Understanding the Contract--Subcontracting Edition**

Another improvement to the Basic Agreement is further guardrails around subcontracting of our work. To be clear, my position, and that of the other West Coast Locals is that all set work belongs to the IATSE. If the employer needs something, they should come to us. But the producers often try to cut corners or lean on old practices of chasing a dollar. We now have stronger notification of subcontracting language; the first tightening of this language in decades. Producers must now supply notification of all subcontracts to affected locals prior to hiring, allowing the Local to evaluate the appropriateness of the subcontract. This will strengthen our jurisdiction and will further illustrate that Union labor is the best choice, and many times the cheaper choice.

But we need your help. If you see non-union labor, whether it's an LED Wall build, poor man's process rig, or an all-in truck built to "make production faster and cheaper" roll into your workplace, let us know. We are here to help protect your work!

### **Entertainment Health Insurance Solutions (EHISCA)**

As was reported at the last General Membership Meeting, MPI is eliminating Premium-Free COBRA for members to help keep the Plans in their current healthy status. This was done in light of projected work hours being lower than normal for the foreseeable future. If you are in danger of losing your MPI insurance, reach out to MPTF for their assistance in finding Health Insurance through the California Marketplace at <u>https://ehisca.com</u>

If you need to request a health insurance consultation, follow these step-by-step instructions:

- Visit the Portal Website: <u>https://ehisca.com/</u>
- Scroll down to: short online form
- Register:
- Enter Personal Information:
  - Fill out the registration form with your personal details: first name, last name, and email address. Note that your email address will be your username. You will also need to create your password and confirm the password. You only need to do this once.
  - **Email Verification:** Check your email for a verification link and click on it to verify your email address.
- Complete Your Profile:
  - If you would like a service like an individual consultation with a Health Benefits Specialist, you must complete your profile. After logging into the client portal, if you have not yet completed it, you will be prompted to complete your profile. You must complete your profile form in order to request any service in the portal.
- Navigate to Counseling & Consultations:
  - Find the "How We Help" section at the top. Click on it, then click on "**Counseling & Consultations**", and then click on "**Health Insurance Counseling**". Complete the form and a team member will reach out to you in 2-3 business days.




# **IATSE Local 728 Food Pantry**


