## IATSE Local 728 Hardship Fund

At our recent November Membership Meeting, changes to our new Local 728 Hardship Fund Loan program were announced. Now to qualify for an interest free loan of up to \$2,500.00, a member needs only to show that they have had \$9,000.00 or less in gross income from covered work in the industry in the past 90 days.


IATSE Local 728 has proudly marched in this celebration since 2010, and we'd love for you to join us this year! 🐥
