LA Fire Disaster Response Update-How can we help?

First, I hope you are all well and safe. I want to take a moment to update you as well as thank our members who are out fighting to both secure and power up homes. The Local remains in your service, and a hub for resources. Thank you for being the active distribution points. To our volunteer members, you are exemplary of the spirit of trade unionism and are to be lauded.

There is a lot of info to cover which I will attempt to do briefly.

We have never seen anything like this. Our members need help, and we are there for them in any way we can. Over 8100 IATSE members were identified earlier this week as living in affected areas. That has been revised down to 5300 members of which **430 are IATSE Local 728 members**. Outreach continues to them to this day.

The **IATSE Walsh/DiTolla/Spivak Foundation** (WDS) that we have supported since we lost Spike stands ready to cut checks to members. It is the fastest way to get members vital financial resources. Five of those checks landed in Burbank this morning.

Today, President Loeb made a plea to all IATSE Locals in the Alliance and its

170,000 members to do all they can for us NOW. To date, the WDS has received \$60,000 in donations and has cut 54 checks with 60 more in process.

Vice President Mike Miller of the IATSE West Coast (WC) office together with the WC Locals have been meeting daily to assess the fluid situation, contact members, as well as collect/distribute resources. We worked together to get both **Local 80 and 892 ready to distribute home goods and clothes**. Over 500 volunteers have pitched in to make it happen!

A total of 315 IA West Coast members have lost their homes including **18 IATSE Local 728 members and 41 displaced** that we know of. The Local has been actively reaching out to those members in the affected areas (**over 400**). Once identified, we have been in constant contact sharing the many Federal, State, and Local resources that are available to them. That communication does not go to all members.

Yesterday, we held a **Resource Event** at Local 80 for those affected. 120 IA members got the chance to work with MPI, MPTF, WDS, and many more vendors to get what they need and a hot meal.




<u>Kingdom Day Parade Postponed: How You Can Help with Fire</u> <u>Relief Efforts</u>
