<u>Understand the contract - "Tech. Rate"</u> Hot Take:

The producer can hire as many members under the Special Lighting Technician (Special Operator/Tech) rate as they want. Any UPM who tells you otherwise is at best uniformed, at worse...lying.

Why it matters:

The Basic Agreement Article 5: Better Conditions allows both the producer and the membership to get more. More money, more rates, more anything in the deal memo and work agreements. In addition, the new contract lays out the "first-of-its-kind" Lighting Control (a.k.a.: "tech") rate under Footnote 8 to the Special Lighting Technician classification. Here's the new language for the Lighting Control (Tech) rate.

"(8) for technicians engaged in lighting control network installation and troubleshooting. It is understood that no more than one employee on the 'off production' crew and one employee on the 'on production' crew shall be entitled to payment under (8) in the preceding sentence."

The issue is that some unit managers are misinterpreting this to mean "no more than one" without reading the "shall be entitled" and hiring only one on each of

our crews. But "entitled" doesn't mean "hired". It means the producer doesn't have to pay for more than one. But they can. And they do.

Takeaway:

<u>Heartbeat of Hollywood – June 2nd</u>


The 47th Annual Heartbeat of Hollywood Gold Classic will be held on June 2, 2025 at Moorpark Country Club and Las Posas Country Club.




